1. Approval of Minutes – Receive and file minutes of the June 1, 2016 meeting.
2. Donation of Land to Monroe County (Public Works) – Request from Tim Keef for Town Board action to donate approximately .034 acres of land at 1941 Elmwood Avenue to Monroe County to allow the MCDOT to perform improvements on Elmwood Avenue and to authorize the Supervisor to execute any related documents (see letter from T. Keef).
3. Amend Contract and Appropriate Funds for Professional Consulting Services for Brickyard Trail (Public Works) – Request from Mike Guyon for Town Board authorization of the Supervisor to amend the agreement with Bayer Landscape Architecture, PLLC for additional professional consulting and inspection services relating to the Brickyard Trail at a cost not-to-exceed \$1,860.23. Request is also sought to transfer \$1,860.23 from the parkland trust fund to the trail capital project to fund said services (see letter from M. Guyon).
4. Budget Appropriation for Construction Services at Brickyard Trail (Public Works) – Request from Mike Guyon for Town Board action to transfer \$8,139.77 from the parkland trust fund to support additional construction services performed by DiFiore Construction Inc. on the Brickyard Trail (see letter from M. Guyon).
5. Grant Acceptance and Appropriation (Public Works) – Request from Mike Guyon for Town Board action to accept grants in the amount of \$2,000 and \$5,000 for an electrical vehicle charging station to be installed at Town Hall and to appropriate such funds in the Town's facilities budget (see letter from M. Guyon).
6. Discussion regarding amendments and extension of the cell tower lease agreement between Sprint Corporation, the Monroe County Water Authority, and the Town of Brighton.

As you may be aware, the MCDOT intends making improvements along Elmwood Avenue to improve the safety of the Lac De Ville intersection. Pursuant to the attached correspondence from Amy E. Grande, dated May 26, 2016, the County has advised the Town of its need to acquire a portion of Town property at the DPW Operations Center, 1941 Elmwood Avenue. Public records indicate that you are the owner of the above-referenced tax parcel which will be impacted by this project. PERMANENT EASEMENT FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES

A permanent easement to be exercised in, on and over the property delineated as Parcel No. 1 above, for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing and maintaining a portion of Elmwood Avenue (C.R. 87), together with appurtenances and other facilities in connection therewith as may be deemed necessary by the Superintendent of Highways.

All that piece or parcel of property hereinafter described as Parcel No. 1, being part of Lot 38, 2nd Division, Township 13 in the Seventh Range of Townships, Town of Brighton, County of Monroe, State of New York, also being a portion of lands described in Liber 9618 of deeds at page 385 filed in the Monroe County Clerk's Office on May 15, 2002 said Parcel No. 1 being shown on the accompanying map and more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the southerly highway boundary of Elmwood Avenue (C.R. 87) and the division line between lands now or formerly owned by the Town of Brighton to the east and the lands now or formerly owned by Convadoloriums, Inc. to the west, said point having the NYS Plane Coordinates of N1,140,499.27 and E1,414,774.58 and being 49.56 feet right of and at right angles to Station 29+73.51 of the hereinafter described 2015 Survey Baseline; thence southerly along said division line a distance of 6.57 feet to a point; said point being 55.59 feet right of and at right angles to Station 29+711 of said baseline; thence N 87°04'51" E through said lands of the Town of Brighton a distance of 331 feet to a point between the division line of lands now or formerly owned by Mary Ellen Lundy, Trustee of the Mary Ellen Lundy Trust to the east and the lands now or formerly owned by the Town of Brighton to the west; said point being 55.32 feet right of and at right angles to Station 30+041 of said baseline; thence northerly along the said division line a distance of 6.57 feet to a point on the southerly highway boundary of Elmwood Avenue (C.R. 87); said point being 49.30 feet right of and at right angles to Station 30+06.38 of said baseline; thence S 87°04'51" W along said southerly highway boundary of Elmwood Avenue (C.R. 87) a distance of 32.87 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.





Dear Councilperson DiPonzo and Committee Members:

The Town Board authorized a bid award to Bayer Landscape Architecture, PLLC to execute an agreement to provide professional services in connection with the development of the Brickyard shared use trail project at a cost not to exceed \$117,550.00. In February 2015 the scope of professional services was expanded to include Phase 1b testing as required by SHPPO at a cost not to exceed \$2,375.

The scope of the original agreement included construction and construction administration services. Bayer Landscape and Architecture has provided outstanding support during the construction phase of the project and while doing so has performed work not identified in the original scope of services. This work includes obtaining mylar drawings as requested by the NYSDEC for the wetland permit and additional site inspection during construction. Bayer Landscape and Architecture is requesting additional compensation of \$1,860.23 for these services.

I am requesting that the FASC recommend that the Town Board authorize the Supervisor to endorse an amendment to the Bayer Architecture, PLLC agreement to complete the services described previously for an amount not to exceed \$1860.23. Also, we are requesting that \$1,860.23 be appropriated from account TE 37 and placed in the capital project account (H.PARKS.EWTRL 2.55) to fund these additional services.

Dear Councilperson DiPonzie and Committee Members:

At their October 14, 2015 meeting the Town Board authorize the Supervisor to execute an agreement with DiFiore Construction as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for construction of the Brickyard Trail for a total cost not to exceed \$826,200.00. Additionally, the Town Board authorized the Supervisor to execute any change orders necessary that do not collectively exceed \$10,000.00. DiFiore has performed admirably and has limited additional work on the project. However, several unforeseen items have arisen during construction and constitute additional work. These items include additional helical pile installation, additional survey for the wetland area, additional tree clearing; replace electrical lighting service, engraved brick pavers for the trailhead and additional tree plantings. The total cost of this additional work is \$8,139.77 which is less than the \$10,000 allocated for change orders.

The total funding allocated for the project was \$826,200 which did not reflect the \$10,000 allocated for potential change orders. Therefore, funding for the change orders must be appropriated into the capital project.

I am requesting that \$8,139.77 be appropriated from account TE 37 and placed in the capital project account (H.PARKS.EWTRL 2.55) to fund this additional work..

Dear Councilperson DiPonzo and Committee Members:

On May 10, 2016 the Town of Brighton received a \$2,000 grant to install an electrical vehicle charging station. Additionally, The Town of Brighton received a \$5,000 grant from the Brighton Rotary Club. I am requesting that the Town Board accept this grant funding and amend the Town budget to reflect these grant funds. We request that these funds be placed in account A.DPW.1620 2.60, Facility Improvements.

Quotes for the electrical vehicle charging station will be sought and presented to the FASC for review. Town forces from the sewer department will install the infrastructure necessary to accommodate the EV charging station. The sewer department estimates that the total material cost excluding the EV charging station will be \$1,800. We request that the expenses related to the installation of the EV charging station incurred by the sewer department be charged to account A.DPW.1620 2.60, Facility Improvements.
