1AR-1-18 — 115 Varinna Drive — Rabbi Herman — Front, rear & side additions and façade changes.

Notes: * Plans, drawings, photos, were presented for review by the board

- * Variances have been applied for.
- * The existing dormer on the front has been moved to center it in the roof
- * The whole house will be re-sided with gray vinyl clapboard
- * The whole house will be re-roofed with black shingles
- * Black vinyl shutters will be used.
- * The garage door will be white with windows
- * Trim will be white Hardi-Board
- * Ledge-stone-style gray stone (Buckingham) will be used.

Decision: Approved **Approved with Conditions** Tabled

1. All required variances shall be obtained.
 2. Cornerboards, as discussed, shall conceal the thickness of the stone veneer on the façade.
 3. White garage doors shall be used with daylight windows
 4. Porch lights shall be recessed in the ceiling
 5. Downspouts shall be located to be as inconspicuous as possible.
 6. Rainwater shall be directed away from the driveway.
