MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: Moment of Silence for Jim Vogel

OPEN FORUM: Bruce Vickers 65 Brooklawn Drive. Expressed concern regarding permitting the ownership of chickens on dense small residential lots. The neighbor's Coop was installed up against the fence. Chickens attract wildlife such as fox, raccoon and rats. Concerned regarding the presence of wild animals close to the children's play area. Playground is within 20 yards of the playground. The Town will investigate the sanitary conditions of the existing chicken coop.

Town residents should contact 911 if animal is acting in an unusual way

Additionally, the next door resident has constructed an addition and the spoil material has not been removed. It appears that the site has not been restored. Public Works will follow up on foundation excavation and determine if it is required to be removed and maintained.

Mr. Vickers also expressed concern regarding the speed of traffic along Brooklawn Dr. Drivers speed to make the light.

Mr. Vickers indicated that the sight distance at pedestrian crossing at Newcrest Drive may not be sufficient. The Department of Public Works will review the sight distance concern.

NETWORKING:

Brighton Ambulance – Highest call month thus far. There were 545 calls in September. Historical data suggests that September results in additional mutual aid calls. 8% rise in calls to date but will likely see a slight increase by the end of the year. Urgent care opened and concern was expressed regarding additional calls generated by the facility. However, a large uptick in calls has not resulted. The grand opening for the Brighton Ambulance facility is November 19th.

Brighton Fire - 1929 Calls to date. Brighton Fire had a successful open house. Kudos to everyone who participated. Fire prevention week this week and the theme is “Look listen be aware fire can happen anywhere” Brighton Fire assisted with the Airport Emergency drill.

Special Events – Homecoming went smooth with the exception of a car accident that occurred just prior to the beginning of the event.
