- **Brighton Ambulance**
  - Calls for Service in March: **570** Call coverage by BVA units is 95%. Volume is up over six percent from this time last year.
  - Participated @ Brighton Fire Open House

  - Open House well attended
  - Continue working on Town parks and Trials to place location markers for emergency responders.
