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**OLD BUSINESS**

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10AR-1-20 — 114 Sylvan Rd — Jesse and Jennifer Readlyn — Renovate and expand front porch

Notes: \* Plans, drawings, and photos were presented for review by the board

- Pressure treated structure – posts and joists
- Wood cladding or trim to be white
- Azek decking
- Shingles to match existing
- Trim painted white
- Side panel infilled with painted wood -blue to match blue accents and shutters
- Underside of porch blue or stained beadboard.
- Maintaining light fixture location
- Columns not symmetric as drawn
- Wood railing painted to match trim

Decision: Approved with conditions

- Locate columns symmetrically under the gable and centered on the door
- Label materials on building permit drawings
- Ensure downspouts are not on the front facade and treated the same as the trim color
- And recommend treating ground under the deck to help with moisture- e.g. grade, ground barrier, stone

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10AR-2-20 — 333 Rhinecliff Dr — David Burrows — 2-story rear addition

Notes: \* were presented for review by the board

- Nothing additional

Decision: As previously approved

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10AR-4-20 — 55 Whitestone Lane — Stahl Property Associates —Dormer addition

Notes: \* Plans, drawings, and photos were presented for review by the board

- Removed center gable
- Reduced the size of the cupola
- Didn't change the center windows as previously recommended because couldn't find stationary windows to match the others
- Eave of the shed extends to the rake of the gable – could be stepped back

Decision: **Approved with recommendations:**

- **Recess overhang above center windows so it does not align with the rake on the gables**

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10AR-8-20 — 144 Hemingway Dr— Ed and Theresa Kwiatkowski — Altering front entrance – moving door and reroofing

Notes: \* Plans, drawings, and photos were presented for review by the board

- No additional plans submitted
- Letter submitted attesting to the fact drainage would be addressed.

Decision: **Postponed by Applicant**

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## NEW BUSINESS

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11AR-1-20 — 88 Southern Parkway — Carini Engineering Designs — Add small mudroom to rear of house (corner lot) and remodel kitchen

Notes: \* Plans, drawings, and photos were presented for review by the board

- Siding stucco finish to match existing
- Brick banding on foundation to match
- Window detailing will try to match existing
- Want to replicate the railing material and style
- Roof of addition will be lower than existing to preserve current window (that will have to be reduced in size)
- Low pitch roof to be tied into current downspout on addition that goes into the underground
- Downspout will be in the center, but hardscape limits moving it to the side
- Noted current locations of wired utilities

Decision: **Tabled:**

- **Reconcile roof heights so that the addition is tied into the existing kitchen addition and main house as a single element**
- **Show routing of the downspouts**
- **Locations for management of utilities**
