CONTINUING BUSINESS

Park Issues: Matt Beeman

- 3 of the 4 seasonal laborer positions have been filled for the summer
- Staff assignments have changed to allow a full time staff member to be on duty during the weekends. This has been hugely successfull
- 4th of July update: Fireworks, Skycoasters, 5K race at Meridian Centre Park (not on the streets)
- Will be reviewing and updating policies based on the recent updates from the State
- Possible vaccine clinic being held during fireworks display was discussed
- Lodge capacity has returned to full capacity, masking will be required for not vaccinated individuals

Recreation Programs: Rebecca Cotter

- Summer Camps are to capacity, we continue to make adjustments as regulations are updated.
- Camp details were discussed.
- Summer Concert Series was discussed. There is a great line up of unique bands performing starting July 6th
- Work continues on the outdoor pool, staff are working to get it operational for a limited opening this summer. Opening date has not been set yet, but will be publicized when we are able to confirm
- Bike Rodeo planning is underway with Brighton Police Department. We are hoping to have it mid July in conjunction with the Brighton Famers Market.

- Sale of the Brookside building was discussed
- Brighton Seniors hope to return to in person programming in the near future. We are working out the best course of action to make their return to in person programs as safe as possible!
- Feasibility Study contract is in for signature, we hope to start work on that soon. The community will be kept up to date with the process and we look forward to their participation!
