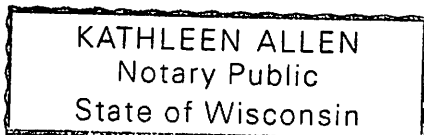

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public meeting will be held by the HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION of the TOWN OF BRIGHTON, Monroe County, at a meeting to be held remotely via a video conferencing platform on Thursday, May 27, 2021 at 7:15 P.M. (E.D.S.T.) or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard regarding the establishment of rules and/or policies pursuant to Town Code Section 224-4 for determining when repairs to and maintenance of landmarks will not require a certificate of appropriateness. The specific rule/policy under consideration is to not require a certificate of appropriateness for the removal of a dead or dying tree from the designated property.
