- **Updates- CAP**

- **Updates- CH&C Mini Campaign**
  - Matt Corona and Brendan have a final draft of the scoping document and it will be reviewed and submitted for approval by NYSERDA
- **Updates- Pollinator Garden**
  - Lac De Ville site is likely out, and a new location will be chosen that helps the Town reduce mowing contracts
  - One major goal is to engage the public by showing the ability of reducing the maintenance of the

- Deerfield site may be a good choice, but not the most visible locations
