OLD BUSINESS

9AR-4-23 - Modification, St Johnsville Trl

Craig Forsey

Modification to the September 26, 2023 ARB approval: change style of all overhead garage doors and changes to Patriot Manor fenestration

Notes: * Plans, drawings, and photos were presented by Craig Forsey, project manager, for review by the board.

- Garage doors:
 - Slightly taller garage door on Patio A, Patio B, and Patriot Manor.
 - Avalon Manor garage door: remove horizontal window grill on windows.
- Patriot Manor:
 - Width of the house increases by 2 feet.
 - 4 individual double-hung windows on left side elevation are replaced with a 3 ganged double-hung windows with transoms above.
 - Fireplace flanked by awning windows.

10AR-2-23 - Revised, 95 Helen Rd

Rho Fallon

Remodel and addition

Notes: * Plans, drawings, and photos were presented by Rho Fallon, owner; Beatriz Machado, architect; for review by the board.

- Revised plans: now just adding a gabled front porch. The second floor addition is no longer proposed.
- Front wall will extend above the door up to the underside of the gable.
- Panel will be the same color as the front door.

- Portico frame: wood, painted white. Vinyl beadboard underneath. No lighting underneath the portico.
- Front second floor addition will have the same roof pitch as the rear second floor.

- Rear facade of the house has a cohesive composition.
