- Calls for service to end of March 2024: 13,018
- Operation Safe Stop - Thursday, April 25, 2024 -is an education and enforcement program to create awareness about the dangers of passing stopped school buses.
- DEA Rx Takeback - April 27th 10a-2p - is on the Public Safety Wing Side
- Kidnapping Case- Numerous resources from NYPD, NYSP, NY/NJ Regional Marshals Task Force. Still gathering documents and evidence to ensure all discovery demands are being met.
- Car thefts - are ticking up mainly on the west side of town.
 - Will be doing some community outreach soon

Overdoses

- From January 1, 2023 – March 19, 2024
 - 26 overdoses
 - 5 have been fatal

Henrietta Fire District

- YTD Calls through March: 1745
- YTD Calls in West Brighton: 226
- Calls of significance: Tractor Trailer came off 390 and struck a home on South Clinton Ave during a snow squall. 1 occupant from the home and the truck driver were transported to

the hospital. Great cooperation between HFD, Brighton Fire (were started in case the road was impassable and would guarantee at least one agency making it to the scene), MCSO, Brighton PD, Town, EMS agencies, utilities, and towing agencies.

- 2 new career firefighters are in the academy, due for graduation in June.
- Tomorrow (April 10th) will be BC Audino's last shift. He retires officially on Monday after 30 years of service.
