OLD BUSINESS

RE MATTER: Update - Crosswalk - Highland Avenue: @ Grosvenor Rd, Pelham Rd, and Council Rock Ave.

Crosswalk Policy continues to be reviewed and will be adopted In the future.

RE MATTER: Update - Crosswalk Penfield Road – Werner

Continue to work with MCDOT about installation of crosswalks at Forest Hills and an additional consideration at Colonial Village (Tree Top Café)

RE MATTER: - Proposed local law to amend Chapter 113 of the Town Code with respect to demonstration and special event permits in Town parks.

Lengthy discussion about permit process and determination of need for permit based on group size and Town Park location.
