- In the process of hiring 8 career firefighters, which will cover retirements and add staffing in line with our long-term staffing plan.
- Henrietta will be hosting the countywide career fire academy which will run from March through May.
- All the terms of the current grant for the West Henrietta Road station have been completed, with the most visible one being completion of the sign on the front of the building. We will be pursuing some additional grant funding to replace the standby generator.
- Though none occurred in the West Brighton area, we have had at least 5 significant fires and several major crashes since the last meeting.
