## Brighton Ambulance Town of Brighton Report January 202

- Brighton Ambulance received a total of 751 calls for service in the month of January 2025 with a total of 554 being in the Brighton Ambulance district. Of these calls 291 were Brighton residents.
- A total of 197 requests for Mutual Aid were received from surrounding ambulances. Of these Brighton responded to 183.
- Code 32 was applied 57 times. Only 1 call was dropped to Mutual Aid with a 99.525% efficacy.
- Brighton total call volume in January 2024 was 775, and 751 in January of 2025, with a decrease of 3.096%
- Brighton has hired several new employees who will start training this week.

## Brighton Fire Department

### Calls of Significance:

- MVA PT on Friday 31 JAN. HFD had the original dispatched. Found the accident in our District and started us. Both departments worked extremely well together. Patients were transported in five different ambulances.

## Henrietta Fire District

- 538 calls for January
- 60 calls in West Brighton

- Overall call volume is down compared to last year, but structural fires are up significantly over this time last year (2 YTD in 2024 vs 12 in 2025)
- The major incident of note in Brighton was the fatal motor vehicle accident on Winton Road. This was originally dispatched to an address on the south side of the canal. HFD units arrived to find it on the north side, placing it in the Brighton Fire District. Brighton was notified to respond, and companies immediately went to work to remove 4 trapped individuals, which involved the removal of the roof and doors. One adult patient was transported in cardiac arrest and subsequently passed at the hospital. As of last report, one child was still in the ICU and the other 2 people in the car, an adult and a child had been treated and released. The total time to remove everyone was 24 minutes from dispatch, which is incredible based on how bad the road conditions were to get to the scene. This was a great reflection of the continuing cooperation between HFD and BFD as well as our EMS partners.
