 - S Clinton Ave resurfacing is coming, road diet may be considered
- CEC
 - All Parks solar projects are under construction
 - Buckland Lodge geothermal contracts are being finalized
- Farmers Market Parking Lot Expansion
 - Currently on hold due to the Brighton High School project being pushed from 2025 to 2026
- Town Hall Parking Expansion
 - Still being pursued as part of the Town Hall project, but there may be opportunity to still change final plans before the
- EECBG
 - No update, waiting on contract award for zoning update
- Multiversity
 - Report 99% done, being submitted to Town Board for any final comments
- Benchmarking Report
 - Completed and ready for submission to the Town Board
 - Emissions are slowly starting to tick downwards in buildings as solar and heat pump projects come online, 2025 should show a larger dip
 - Townwide electricity consumption is down roughly 32% from 2017, mostly due to streetlight conversions
