CONTINUING BUSINESS

Parks Update: Matt Beeman

- Fall Youth Sports starting back up, longer seasons
- Field use pressures increasing from the community and Brighton Central School District as BCSD fields are being redone
- Discussions regarding concerns with increased demands on field use and users of the fields
- 1500 ft of trail maintenance underway at Corbett's Glen
- Focusing on the worst portions of the trail to improve conditions and make repairs
- Discussion of condition of the wooden bridge under the CSX train trellis, not Town Property, CSX responsibility
- Working with Birchcrest Tree to obtain hardwood chips to be used on the trails free of charge
- 300 cubic yards of playground mulch has been spread on the playgrounds in the parks
- Twelve Corners Park Improvements: \$500 donation from Garden Lovers Club of Brighton planted over 70 mums on the corners

- Hornet and Yellow Jackets have been terrible in the parks this year, working with extermination company to mitigate the situation

Recreation Programs: Rebecca Cotter

- Homecoming Parade: Saturday, September 20 – Electric is on at Twelve Corners for the event
- Recreation Department will be participating driving the rec van
- Trunk or Treat, Golisano Institute to host this year due to construction at Town Hall
- Fall program registration is going well. Senior Fitness programs are free for Brighton Residents, ARPA Grant
- Preschool Program revamp is underway with our new Recreation Leader
- Staffing: Full Time/Part Time, in the process of hiring to replace a full time recreation leader and a part time office staff person
- New York State Historic Preservation Grant letter of interest has been submitted in hopes of securing funding for renovations to the Buckland House
- Bricks Grant application was submitted in August
- Discussion of AED/Naloxone at Barn requesting that they be added
- Discussion of vandalism of Naloxone at Buckland Park, vandalism hasn't been an issue in the other parks
- Discussion of Naloxone training for Town employees and community members

Farmers' Market/Community Garden/Tree Nursery Update

- Preparations for winter market resuming at the Barn
- Bike Collection Day at Brighton Farmers Market with R Community Bikes in collaboration with Brighton Rotary was a great success
- Last outdoor day November 16th, indoors on November 24
- Discussion of Community Garden, more updates to follow after it wraps up for the season
- Tree Nusery is going well
