Brighton Ambulance

March 2025

- Brighton Ambulance received a total of 731 calls for service in the month of March 2025. Total of 520 were in the Brighton Ambulance district. Of these calls 312 were Brighton residents.
- Brighton had a total of 137 requests for Mutual Aid from surrounding Ambulances. Of these Brighton responded to 99.
- Code 32 was applied 38 times and no calls were dropped to Mutual Aid with a 100% efficacy.
- Brighton call volume is up 11.773% from 2024, with 2024 2083 and currently call volume of 2226.
- Brighton is currently fully staffed.
- Brighton Open House will be May 18th 1-4
- We have our training center back up and running and will be pushing community CPR at our Open House in May.
