## Brighton Ambulance Report April 2025

- Brighton Ambulance received a total of 722 calls for service in the month of April 2025. A total of 521 were in the Brighton Ambulance district. Of these calls 275 were Brighton residents.
- Brighton had a total of 201 requests for Mutual Aid from surrounding Ambulances. Of these Brighton responded to 145.
- Code 32 was applied 56 times, and 5 calls were dropped to Mutual Aid with a 97.200 % efficacy.
- Brighton call volume is up 7.620 % from 2024, with 2024 2752 and currently call volume of 2949.
- Brighton is currently fully staffed. Currently we have hired 20 employees in the last 4 months.
- Brighton Open House will be May 18th 1-4
- We have our training center back up and running and will be pushing community CPR at our Open House in May.
