The following resolution was offered by Councilmember Werner, who moved its adoption, seconded by Councilmember Corrado, to-wit:

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON,
MONROE COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE "TOWN") (I) CALLING FOR A
PUBLIC HEARING IN ACCORDANCE TO SECTION 202-b OF THE
TOWN LAW TO CONSIDER AUTHORIZING IMPROVEMENTS TO THE
TOWN OF BRIGHTON CONSOLIDATED SEWER DISTRICT; AND (II)
(II) DETERMINING THAT SUCH IMPROVEMENTS CONSTITUTE A
TYPE II ACTION UNDER THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY
REVIEW ACT**

WHEREAS, the Town Board (the "Town Board") of the Town of Brighton, Monroe County, New York (the "Town") is considering authorizing certain improvements to the Town of Brighton Consolidated Sewer District (the "District") consisting of the acquisition of a Ford F-350 SuperCab 4-wheel drive pickup truck (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Town's engineers have estimated that the maximum cost of undertaking the Project is \$45,000; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board now intends to conduct a public hearing in accordance with Section 202-b of the Town Law with respect to undertaking the Project at such estimated maximum cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby calls for a public hearing to be held at a public meeting of the Town Board to be held via Video Conference pursuant to Governor Cuomo's Executive Order 202.1 as extended, on June 9, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. to consider if it is in the public interest to undertake the Project at a maximum cost of \$45,000 and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof; and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby directed to cause notice of such public hearing to be published and posted in the manner prescribed by law; and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED, is hereby determined that the Project constitutes a "Type II" Action under of the State Environmental Quality Review Act and the regulations of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation promulgated thereunder (collectively "SEQRA") and no further action need be taken under SEQRA by this Board in connection with the Project or the Town Board's consideration thereof.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
