

**SUMMARY OF ELECTOR INITIATED PROPOSED DISSOLUTION PLAN FOR THE
WEST BRIGHTON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

PURSUANT TO GML 782

The entity to be dissolved is the West Brighton Fire Protection District. The territorial boundaries of the West Brighton Fire Protection District are that part of the Town of Brighton, County of Monroe, State of New York that is North of the Henrietta Town Line, South & West of the Erie Canal, South & East of the Genesee River. The fiscal estimate of the cost of dissolution includes the cost of purchasing a fire engine for the Henrietta Fire District at a cost of approximately \$500,000.00. The position of District Administrator for the West Brighton Fire Protection District would be eliminated upon dissolution. The real property located at 2695 West Henrietta Road is to be transferred to the Henrietta Fire District. The Henrietta Fire District proposes to absorb the current area located in the Town of Brighton and known as the West Brighton Fire Protection District into the Henrietta Fire District. Upon the effective date of the dissolution of the West Brighton Fire Protection District the boundaries of the Henrietta Fire District would be simultaneously expanded to include those areas formerly included within the West Brighton Fire Protection District. Thereafter fire service and first response to medical emergencies would be provided within such area by the Henrietta Fire District. Services will be provided by a combination of career paid fire fighters and volunteers. The Effective Date of Dissolution will be January 1, 2022. The Public Hearing on the extension of the Henrietta Fire District will be held on July 28, 2021 at 7:00 pm or as soon thereafter as the hearing can be held at the Brighton Town Hall, 2300 Elmwood Avenue in the Town of Brighton, County of Monroe, State of New York.
