

Legal Notice of Public Hearing on the Proposed Partial Real Property Tax Exemption for First Responders

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that proposed resolution to adopt the Partial Real Property Tax Exemption for First Responders residing in the Brighton Fire District of the Towns of Brighton and Pittsford, State of New York, set forth in N.Y. Real Property Tax Law Section 466-k(l), will be presented to the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Brighton Fire District, for its consideration.

A PUBLIC HEARING will be held at 7:00 p.m. at the Brighton Fire District Station #1, 3100 East Avenue, in the Town of Brighton, State of New York on the 3rd day of February, 2022.

The Board of Fire Commissioners is required to hold a public hearing on the proposed exemption, and allow the public to comment on the exemption at the public hearing. This public hearing must be held to allow maximum public participation in the hearing.

The purpose of the public hearing is to allow any person to be heard in favor of or against the proposed exemption as it is submitted, and hearing all persons interested in the subject concerning the same.
