Description:

- Perform lifeguard duties during a Water Exercise Class for older adults.
- The pool is approximately 3½ feet deep.

Responsibilities:

- Monitor the swimming pool during Seniors Water Exercise class times, manage pool area, and ensure the safety of participants and staff.
- In the event of a water emergency, you are responsible for getting the participant out of the water and beginning rescue procedures following outlined emergency action plan.
- Guards must arrive 15 minutes before each class begins and stay until the pool deck is clear of all patrons
- If you are unable to report for your assignment you will need to call with as much advance notice as possible. The class cannot be held without a lifeguard.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be (16) years old and possess the following certifications: CPR/AED for professional rescuers AND Basic Lifeguard Training, First Aid.

Hours: Wednesday evenings from 6:15 - 7:45 pm and/or Saturday mornings from 9:15 - 10:45 am
