Dear Stakeholder

The New York State Department of Transportation plans the following pavement resurfacing project to begin in the Spring of 2026 within the Towns of Brighton, Chili, and Gates and the City of Rochester, Monroe County:

- Project PIN 4390.95 — Interstate 390 from Canal Bridge at Exit 16 to Route 33A

The project is scheduled to take two construction seasons and be completed by the end of August 2027. The Department will provide additional announcements when construction beginning and end dates are determined.

The project will achieve the Department's goals to enhance safety and improve efficiency by:

- Resurfacing existing pavement
- Repairing and rehabilitation of drainage system
- Replacing guide rail and median barrier
- Replacing ground mounted signs and overhead sign panels
- Repair and maintenance of bridge decks

I-390 will remain open to traffic during construction. Most work will occur in the evening and overnight hours, and traffic impacts will include nighttime lane closures and/or ramp closures with detours.

Motorists will be kept informed via variable message boards and temporary work zone traffic control signs as the project progresses. Real-time traffic and construction updates can also be found by visiting www.511ny.org.
