RESOLVED, that correspondence dated February 7, 2013 from Commissioner of Public Works, Timothy E. Keef, P.E., regarding setting a public hearing pursuant to Section 8 of Chapter 175 of the Town Code relative to the removal of significant town trees found by the Commissioner to be appropriate for removal identified as a 38" Black Locust at 35 Monteroy Road, a 37" Silver Maple at 60 Greenaway Road, a 45" Silver Maple at 68 Greenaway Road and a 30" Norway Maple at 76 Cheswell Way, be received and filed; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby sets a public hearing at Brighton Town Hall, 2300 Elmwood Avenue in the Town of Brighton, New York for March 13, 2013 at 7:30 pm or as soon thereafter as such hearing can be held pursuant to Section 8 of Chapter 175 of the Town Code relative to the removal of significant town trees which have been identified by the Commissioner to be appropriate for removal consisting of the following trees: a 38" Black Locust at 35 Monteroy Road, a 37" Silver Maple at 60 Greenaway Road, a 45" Silver Maple at 68 Greenaway Road and a 30" Norway Maple at 76 Cheswell Way ; and be it further

RESOLVED, that notice of such public hearing shall be sent by first class mail at least 20 days prior to said hearing addressed to the owners of each of the properties adjoining each

of the above trees proposed for removal and the owners directly across the Town highway from and the properties contiguous to the adjoining properties that front on the same Town highway
