

The Town Board of the Town of Brighton adopted on June 22, 2016 the following resolution granting an easement to the County of Monroe. The resolution is subject to permissive referendum:

BE IT RESOLVED, that correspondence dated June 10, 2016 from Commissioner of Public Works Timothy E. Keef, P.E. regarding a request to authorize the Supervisor to execute an easement agreement and related documents to grant to the County of Monroe permanent and temporary easements at the DPW Operations Center, 1941 Elmwood Avenue for the purpose of making certain improvements along Elmwood Avenue to improve safety at the Lac De Ville intersection, and correspondence dated May 26, 2016 from Amy E. Grange, Monroe County Real Estate Specialist, together with attachments hereto, be received and filed; and further

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby authorizes the Supervisor to execute an easement agreement and related documents to grant to the County of Monroe permanent and temporary easements at the DPW Operations Center, 1941 Elmwood Avenue, as shown in the attachments to the correspondence from Monroe County referenced above, for the purpose of making certain improvements along Elmwood Avenue to improve safety at the Lac De Ville intersection, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the granting of the permanent easement above is subject to permissive referendum pursuant to Town Law Section 64(2) and the Clerk of the Town shall post and publish notice of the adoption of this resolution pursuant to the provisions of Town Law Section 90.
