

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At a Town Board Meeting of the Town of Brighton, Monroe County, New York, held at the Brighton Town Hall, 2300 Elmwood Avenue, in said Town of Brighton on the 11th day of April, 2018.

PRESENT: WILLIAM W. MOEHLE, Supervisor and JAMES R. VOGEL, CHRISTOPHER K. WERNER, JASON S. DIPONZIO, ROBIN R. WILT, Councilmembers

WHEREAS, a Map, Plan and Report regarding the Brighton Consolidated Sewer District's proposed realignment of a sanitary sewer and replacement of a sanitary sewer control valve on Blossom Road in the Town of Brighton prepared by the Town Engineer, Michael E. Guyon, P.E. which estimated that the cost to the District of the proposed improvements will cost \$348,459.00, together with correspondence from the Town Engineer dated July 11, 2017 regarding the proposed improvements and correspondence from Finance Director Suzanne Zaso dated July 10, 2017 indicating the District's intent to borrow through bonding \$350,000.00 for the improvements was received and filed on July 12, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board duly held a public hearing pursuant to Section 202-b of the Town Law of the State of New York to consider whether it would be in the public interest to undertake the proposed improvements and borrowing on behalf of the District on August 9, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at Brighton Town Hall, 2300 Elmwood Avenue, in the Town of Brighton, County of Monroe and State of New York and at that time all persons who had an interest in said proposed improvement had an opportunity to address the Town Board on the subject of the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, following the conclusion of the public hearing the Town adopted a resolution pursuant to Section 202-b of the Town Law of the State of New York to undertake the proposed improvements and borrowing on behalf of the District, and

WHEREAS, upon receipt and review of the construction bids submitted for the project it was determined that the actual costs to complete the improvements would be higher than initially estimated with the lowest responsible, responsive bid coming in at \$359,950 plus a construction contingency allowance of 10% for a new estimated total cost of the project of \$439,545, now be it

RESOLVED, that correspondence dated April 6, 2018 from Assistant Engineer Evert Garcia regarding a request to set a public hearing for the Town Board to consider amending its prior resolution pursuant to Town Law Section 202-b to undertake the project for the new estimated total cost and to amend the bonding resolution in connection therewith, be received and filed; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby sets a public hearing pursuant to Section 202-b of the Town Law of the State of New York to consider whether it would be in the public interest to undertake the proposed improvements and borrowing on behalf of the District and to amend its prior resolution dated August 9, 2017 regarding the improvement work for May 9, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard at Brighton Town Hall, 2300 Elmwood Avenue, in the Town of Brighton, County of Monroe and State of New York to hear all persons who have an interest in said proposed improvement, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be, and hereby is directed to publish a certified copy of this Resolution in the official newspaper of the Town and to post a certified copy of this Resolution on the signboard of the Town no sooner than twenty days and no later than ten days prior to said public hearing.
