### SUMMARY OF BOND RESOLUTION

Set forth below is a summary of said resolution adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Brighton, Monroe County, New York (the “Town”) on July 11, 2018.

1. The resolution is entitled “BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON, MONROE COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE “TOWN”), AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$120,000 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE TOWN TO UNDERTAKE CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON CONSOLIDATED SEWER DISTRICT”.

2. The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized: consisting of the acquisition of sewer camera inspection equipment to include cameras, tack system, track extension kits, spare parts kits, cables, flat screen monitor, controllers, mounting rack, software and training and one (1) one-ton 6-wheel dump truck.

3. The period of probable usefulness is five (5) years.

4. The amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$120,000.
