The validity of the obligations authorized by such resolution may be hereafter contested only if such obligations were authorized for an object or purpose for which the Town of Brighton is not authorized to expend money or if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of publication of this notice, or such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

### SUMMARY OF BOND RESOLUTION

Set forth below is a summary of said resolution adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Brighton on July 11, 2018.

1. The resolution is entitled “BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON, MONROE COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE “TOWN”), AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF ONE PARCEL OF LAND CONTAINING IN THE AGGREGATE APPROXIMATELY 26 ACRES LOCATED ON SOUTH WINTON ROAD WITHIN THE TOWN; STATING THE MAXIMUM ESTIMATED COST THEREOF IS \$1,256,015; APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT THEREFOR; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$995,000 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE TOWN TO FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF UP TO \$209,225 FROM THE TOWN’S PARKS RESERVE FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF UP TO \$51,790 FROM THE TOWN’S QUALITY OF LIFE RESERVE FUND”.

2. Object or Purpose: the acquisition of one parcel of land containing in the aggregate approximately 26 acres located on South Winton Road within the Town, constituting a portion of an approximately 71-acre parcel of land currently owned by Faith Temple.

3. Period of Probable Usefulness: 30 years.

4. Amount of Debt Obligations Authorized: \$995,000.
