Dogs:



Homeowners are allowed maximum of 3 dogs. NY State Law requires all dogs to be licensed upon reaching four months of age. All dogs in Brighton are required to be restrained by a leash no longer than 20 feet in length while off the owner's premises. Any Brighton Police Officer or Animal Control Officer may seize any dog not on the owner's premises or any unlicensed dog, whether or not on the owner's premises in accordance with NY State Law. Building Services



Sheds/Gazebos:

For complete permit and fee information visit our website Building and Planning Page or call the Planning Department at 784-5226. Permits are required for fences, sheds, decks, air conditioners, generators, in-ground and above-ground pools and some roofing projects. Here is a short overview:

Rear Yard only – 5' from any property line (rear and side) no taller than 16' or larger than 250 SF. Permit required.

Fences:



Height Restrictions- 3'6" front yard, 6'6" side and rear yard (must include finials & posts) can go up to property line but not on it. Permit required.

AC Units:

Side or Rear yard only, 5' from property line, no louder than 78 decibels, and unit must be screened from neighboring properties with fencing or shrubbery to reduce visual impact. Permit required.

Swimming Pools/Hot Tubs:



Rear yard only – 10' from side and rear property lines (including any decking); must be enclosed with fence 4' high and gate capable of being locked or access area to pool must be properly fenced, complete details can be found on website Building and Planning page under Departments or call the Planning Department at (585) 784-5226

Additions:

Visible from the street? - may require Architectural Review Board approval (application). Must meet side setbacks (15% of the lot width) and front/rear setbacks (either 40' or 60'-check zoning maps) complete details can be found on website Building and Planning page under Departments or call the Planning Department at 784-5226

Front Yard Parking

Parking of vehicles on grassed areas is not allowed

Winter Parking Restrictions

The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited on, or within three feet of the pavement of, all highways within the Town of Brighton between 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. from November 1 to April 15.

Campers & Trailers

Outside parking on residential lots of campers or other vehicles or trailers greater than 24' in length OR 6' in height is prohibited for longer than 72 hours within any four day period.

Junk Vehicles

“Junk” vehicles are any motor vehicles (motorcycles, cars, trucks, mobile homes, buses, etc.) that are unregistered and/or uninspected and that are not intended or able to be driven. Junk vehicles are not permitted anywhere on parcels.

Leaf & Yard Debris Collection



The Town does not pick up Grass clippings. The Town does provide bulk and containerized leaf and yard debris collection services. See our website for complete details. Please place brush, leaves and garden debris at the curb in containers or paper bags – not in plastic bags, or in a neatly stacked pile, no more than eight feet long, and free of sod, dirt, or construction debris.

Placing debris or leaves anywhere in the street is against the law anywhere in the Town of Brighton.
